FASHIONS ON THE FIELD COMPETITION (the "Competition")

2010 TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Competition is a game of skill not chance. The Competition will be judged by a panel of judges.
2. Rules on how to enter the Competition and for each category of the Competition form part of these Terms and Conditions of entry.
3. Entry to the Competition will be refused if a contestant does not meet the entrant criteria set out in these Terms and Conditions.
4. Entrants must be 18 years of age or more on the day of the Competition they are entering. Proof of age must be provided at the time of registration unless the entrant pre-registers by completing the online registration form.
5. Subject to clause 6 of these Terms and Conditions, all entrants must register at the registration desk located at the Registration Tent next to the Fashions on the Field enclosure on the Royal Randwick Racecourse premises by 12.00pm on the day of the judging of the Competition they are entering. The AJC reserves the right to refuse entry to any participant.
6. Entrants may pre-register before the judgment day of the Competition by filling out the registration form on the AJC website at www.pinkstileto.com.au
7. Contestants may only enter one category in the Competition. The rules applying to each category of the Competition are on the AJC website www.pinkstileto.com.au
8. Entrants must present themselves to the Fashions on the Field enclosure 15 minutes prior to their heat.
9. Winners in each category of the Competition must inform the AJC of any proposed interview with any media about the Competition and may conduct interviews with such media only after obtaining the AJC's consent to do so. The AJC will be entitled to reclaim or withdraw any prize awarded to any winner of the Competition who breaches this condition.
10. The entrant acknowledges that the AJC has obligations to its sponsors. Entrants must not commercially promote any brand, store, product or designer in relation to the Competition and must not enter the Competition on behalf of any other person or accept payment or other compensation from any person to enter the Competition or to wear any particular outfit, make-up, footwear or accessories in the Competition.
11. Prizes cannot be transferred, exchanged or redeemed for cash. Contestants may sell their prizes but if they do so, they must not reveal where they came from.
12. Conditions apply to gift vouchers prizes. The gift vouchers cannot be used to make credit payments. The gift vouchers apply to full price merchandise and cannot be used in conjunction with any other special offers or discounts otherwise offered by the entity who issues the gift vouchers.
13. Conditions apply to travel and accommodation prizes. These prizes must be taken as specified. Timing is subject to availability.
14. If a prize is unavailable for any reason the AJC may substitute a prize of equivalent value.
15. The AJC and AJC's nominees will select the judging panel for the Competition and the judges' decision is final. In the event of a draw, the AJC's selected adjudicator will determine the winner. Winners will be notified on the day of their heat.
16. Staff of the AJC, host, judges and the Competition sponsors and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the Competition.
17. The AJC may enter all personal information provided on registration entry forms and other related documentation into a database and use and disclose all such personal information (including names and addresses) for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes, unless the entrant has opted-out of this permitted purpose on the registration form for the Competition.
18. All entry forms become the property of the AJC.
19. Entrants agree they may be filmed, photographed and/or interviewed and that their names and images may be used by the AJC, its sponsors and other third parties for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes.
20. Winners of all categories of the Competition agree that they will make themselves available for at least six public appearances at the request of the AJC during 2010.
